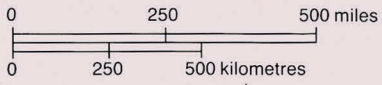
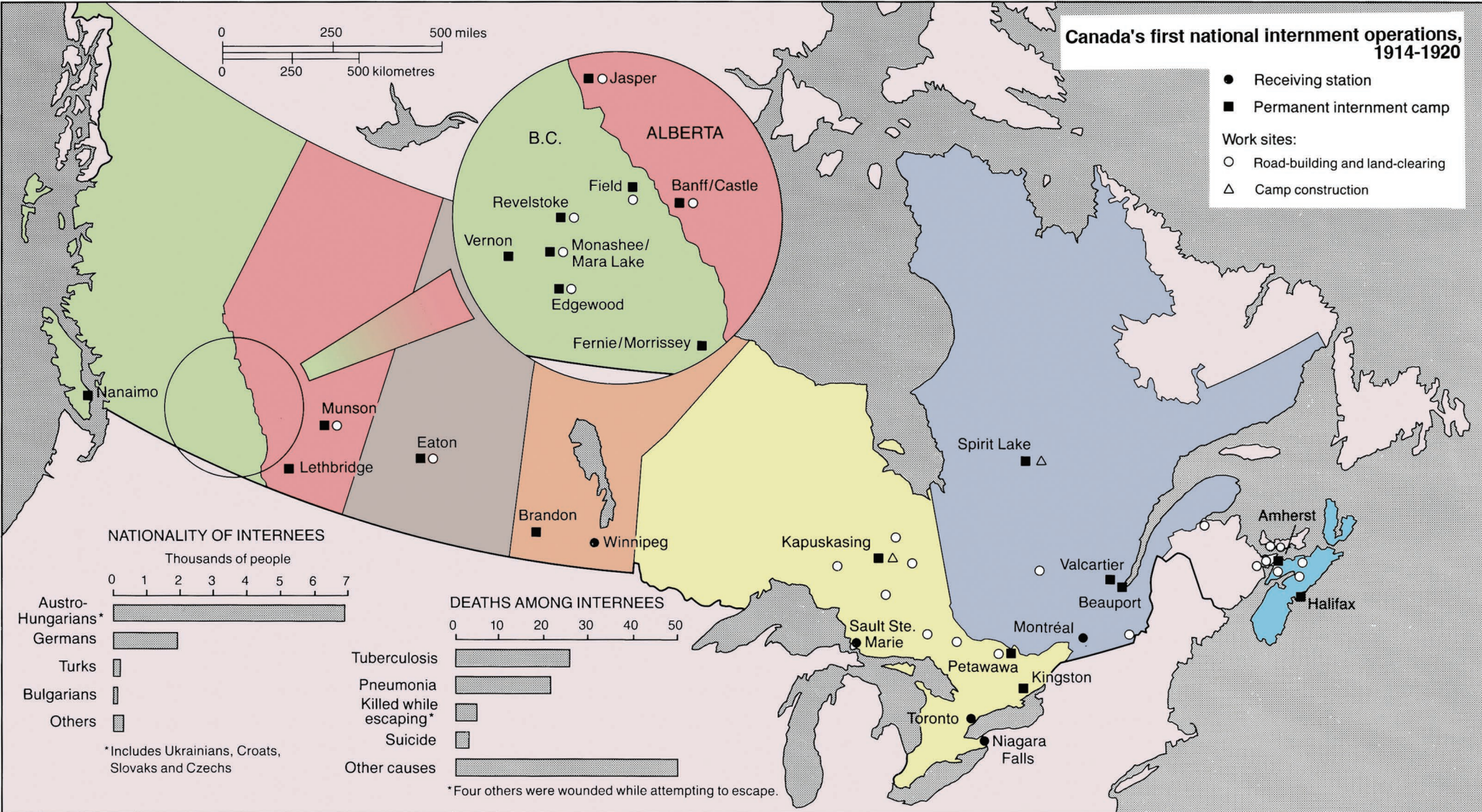


Canada's first national internment operations, 1914-1920
